- current certification in Peripheral Intravenous Initiation and Maintenance
- current certification in Central Line Management
- current Neurosurgical certification

Experience:

- minimum of 1 year full-time equivalent experience (within the last 5 years) in orthopedic or neurosurgery nursing

General Skills:

- patient teaching skills
- positive interpersonal relations
- ability to work in a high-paced organized, team environment
- strong therapeutic communication skills
- computer skills including Microsoft Office software, Meditech Client Service OE, and GRASP software

Preference Given to:

- current certification in Non Violent Crisis Intervention
- current certification in Central Venous Line care and removal
- current certification in Chest Tube Care and Removal
- current certification in Intrathecal Pain Management
- demonstrated experience in orthopaedics total joint care
