Position: REGISTERED NURSE
Department: Systemic Treatment - Outpatient Clinic
Program: Northeast Cancer Centre (NECC)
Location: Ramsey Lake Health Centre - Northeast Cancer Centre

Purpose: This primary nurse position provides support and coordination for oncology patients within the outpatient clinics of the Northeast Cancer Centre.

Standard Qualifications:

- a graduate from an approved School of Nursing (university or community college) with a current certificate of competence with the College of Nurses of Ontario

Required Qualifications:

- current certification in Basic Cardiac Life Support **BCLS**
- current certification in Peripheral Intravenous Initiation and Maintenance
- certification in Canadian Nurses Association's Oncology Nursing **CNA** or must be obtained within two (2) years

Experience:

- minimum 2 years full-time equivalent experience (within the last 5 years) in oncology nursing
- minimum 2-3 years general nursing experience (within the last 5 years) in an acute clinical care setting

General Skills:

- strong communication, interpersonal and organizational skills
- demonstrated ability to work independently
- computer skills including Microsoft Office software, Meditech Client Service OE, Enterprise Medical Records, and Mosaiq

Preference Given to:

- previous experience in working in an outpatient setting
- completion of a recognized Oncology course
